**Michael Laws conduct probe resumes this week**

**The investigation into code of conduct complaints against Wanganui Mayor Michael Laws continues this week.**

Deputy mayor and audit and administration committee chairwoman Dot McKinnon said the committee will review its deliberations this Friday in a public-excluded meeting.

The committee adjourned the investigation after a hearing of complaints by Valerie Calder, Warwick Chapman, Carol Webb, Matt Dutton, William Pearce and Jay Kuten on March 31.

The six allege the mayor breached the code on a number of occasion under several different categories.

"The adjournment was to allow us to acquaint the Mayor, who was not present at the investigation, with supplementary material given out by the complainants and to request his response," Ms McKinnon said.

"This was in fairness to the Mayor and in accordance with due process."
